2. REPORT FROM THE CEO

The Chair welcomed Mark Lamb, CEO who gave the group a verbal update on the below topics:

- Cr Tilley and Mark met with Tea Tree Gully Council's CEO, Mr Ryan McMahon and Mayor Marijka Ryan who were very excited to hear about to future plans of the Murray Darling Association and will be considering joining Region 7 again.
- Recently met with the Queensland Council of Mayors to emphasise the importance of all Council's being a member of this organisation. We cannot achieve without full support and Council's cannot rely on other Council's to advocate on their behalf. The meeting was positive with Council's considering re-joining. There are 167 Council's in the Basin – the more members we have, the bigger the voice.
- Motions have been working in the background to ensure transparency so that all members can easily know where a motion has gone and where it is up to.
- Have built a new website, it is secure and has the functionality to book within it without
 having to rely on an external site. Actions as a result of motions are now searchable on the
 site and a new newsletter has been created (circulated with minutes)
- Waste reform taskforce

 Project Waste to Energy.
- The organization is working on the image that they are representing Local Government, but broader than water expertise.
- Collaborations in the works with SQ&NSW and OneBasin CRC hoping to get funded intel
