A follow-up email was sent to the Office of Minister Speirs on 4 October 2018 who advise that the response from the Department is currently with a Ministerial Adviser for review before being progressed to the Minister.

In recent months, there have been calls for water held by the Commonwealth Environmental



Water Holder (CEWH) to be made available to support farmers and irrigators experiencing dry conditions in Victoria and New South Wales.

- note our continuing support for full and timely implementation of the Basin Plan which seeks to restore balance between water for the environment and water for consumptive use, including in times of drought; and
- record our opposition to legislative amendments which would alter the current framework applying to the trade or use of water allocations held by the Commonwealth Environmental Water Holder.

**Meeting with Emma Bradbury, CEO Murray Darling Association and Mayor Brenton Lewis, Rural City of Murray Bridge (attending on behalf of MDA Region 6)**

Background

- MDA Region 6 represents the Lower Murray, Lakes and Coorong. Local Government membership of MDA Region 6 consists of Alexandrina Council, Coorong District Council, Rural City of Murray Bridge and Tatiara District Council.
- Local Government requires State and Commonwealth support to undertake climate change adaptation planning for the Coorong and Lower Lakes. The barrages are “River Murray Operation Assets” jointly controlled by the Australia, New South Wales, Victorian and South Australian governments.
- A dedicated program of research and community engagement is needed to inform development of a preferred climate change adaptation pathway for environmental and economic water management within the Coorong and Lower Lakes region.
- Region 6 welcomes the release of the Coorong Summit and Goyder Expert Panel Reports.

**The Murray Darling Association and Region 6 – Lower Murray, Lakes & Coorong respectfully request that the SA Government:**

1. Establish and lead an intergovernmental taskforce (local, state and federal) on climate change adaptation planning for the Coorong and Lower Lakes;
2. Advocate for this taskforce at a Basin Officials Committee and Ministerial Council level;
3. Support the development and delivery of education resources to inform upstream communities of the importance of the barrages in a healthy, working Basin; and
4. Identify the need for a quadruple bottom line climate change vulnerability assessment for the entire Coorong and Lower Lakes region in the *Coorong Futures* business case being prepared for submission to the Commonwealth Department of Agriculture and Water Resource.

To whom it may concern,

The Murray Darling Association is the peak body representing local government at state and federal level with respect to the management of Basin water resources. In South Australia, the MDA consists of four regions (Regions 5-8) with 28 member councils, representing all South Australian communities which rely on Basin water resources. This includes non-riparian councils who rely on the River Murray to meet critical human water needs. I am Chair of MDA Region 6 – Lower Murray, Lakes & Coorong, with active participation from Alexandrina, Murray Bridge, and Coorong District Councils.

MDA Region 6 – ‘Murray to Mouth’ support the submission made by the Murray Darling Association to this process in October 2018. This document is reattached for reference.

Further to this MDA Region 6 – ‘Murray to Mouth’ also submit that:

- We would like the Murray-Darling Basin Water Infrastructure Program to ensure dryland livestock producers who are wholly dependent on SA Water mains sourced from the River Murray are eligible for this Program. Ensuring that funding is made available to assist livestock producers to stop using River Murray mains water, or greatly reduce their usage across SA convert to a real contribution to target the 450GL saving. This would greatly assist one of the largest industries in the South Australian economy, and return water to the River Murray.
- MDA Region 6 also support the inclusion of Urban Water Efficiency measures, such as CWMS and implementation of other innovative water technologies.
- All submissions made and the Final Report be made public.
- That once this report is released all organisations and individuals who made submissions are notified.
- That ensuring that this happens will enhance understanding of concerns, issues and opportunities basin wide.
