- Neil is fair minded and will engage in his position in the best interests of the MDB.
- Neil is held with a great deal of respect from his position of speaker in the Federal House of Representatives and will bring a balanced view of the situation within the Basin with a wealth of knowledge gleaned during the drought. His office will always be open for members of MDA.
- There is still \$25-M for water diversion available from the Federal Government being held by the SA State Government.
- Tony expressed his desire and willingness to work with our members and attend as many meetings as possible and added his office is always open to assist.

The secretary thanked Hon Tony Pasin for attending our meeting and for his commitment realising he had much to learn and desire to continue assisting though admitting there seemed to be a different view of the MDB and its water upstream of Lock 1.
