- What is the water allocation currently in other states?
 - NSW with small volume of High Security, nearly all growers on zero in past water year / some relief possible but all dependent on rainfall.
 - SA is in a more fortunate position, with larger % of high security but current allocations at 22%. Potential to raise but dependent on rainfall across the southern basin.
- Discussion around media reports of water being held in dams to stop it entering the Darling.

5. MDA Region 5

- 5.1 Myles Fauser EO, Renmark Irrigation Trust (RIT) & Renmark Paringa Council (RPC)
 - Myles shared with us the exciting work with:
 - Commonwealth Environmental Water Holder (CEWH) / RIT / RPC Cooperation, with a partnership agreement .
 - The project stems back from 2013, with Johnsons Waterhole on the Ral Ral Floodplain, which was highlighted in the vision for SEE Renmark 2024. 500 Ha floodplain jointly owned, the outcomes are to rehabilitate landscapes, create habitat for endangered species and generate an example of localism through community engagement and involvement.
 - In 2016 we entered into a Partnership Agreement with the CEWH to deliver Commonwealth Environmental Water to floodplains adjacent to the Renmark irrigation area utilising the Renmark Irrigation Trust's infrastructure. Five sites currently underway another 5 initiated for action & a further 5 for short term activation.
 - The future: 15 Sites identified as viable for environmental water delivery through RIT infrastructure. Renmark Environmental Watering Committee will facilitate delivery to other sites & may involve other partners (ie Nature Foundation of South Australia).
 - 2019 Management Guidelines: Renmark Environmental Watering Committee Member Mike Harper commissioned provide detailed reports to amalgamate into a final iteration.

- Environmental Watering Monitoring Operational Plan: Guiding document for environmental watering operations and monitoring, designed, written and actioned by Renmark Paringa Council Environmental Officer Myles Fauser.
- Initial results: Namoi St Řenmark North 36ml of water delivered between April to June 2019, comparison video was shown of drone footage from 20 March 2019 to 2 May 2019. Results show the total water bird species increased, in addition to frog sitings. All sites with monitoring /evaluation.
- Full documentation of watering schedules / drying cycles produced & available
- Excellent examples of documented, provable environmental gains are in place for ongoing monitoring

We paused the meeting agenda (10:29am) to welcome Emma Bradbury, CEO MDA – via Zoom video link.

(6.0) Emma Bradbury, CEO MDA

 - Basin Community Leadership Program we were asked if there been any expression of interest from members in participation.
 - Action: Chair to distribute information and criteria on the program & ask for potential applicants from our region/s.
 - MDA will hold a board meeting at the ALGA NGA scheduled for 19 June 2019, in Canberra. The MDA will also have an exhibit / stall at the National LGA Meeting.
 - Connecting Catchments and Communities From Menindee to the Murray Mouth session in Renmark was very well received. Positive feedback on the high level of speakers - in addition to the level of engagement and expertise from the audience. A session to be scheduled for Region 6 in the near future.

 - What is the mood across the MDA in terms of Local Government? How is the community's travelling with water allocations?
 - Emma said she has seen a significant shift since the State and Federal Elections, since the Federal Election, it seems there are a lot more constructive approaches – starting to regroup. More collaborative than in recent years.
 - Has Emma heard of Community/Industry groups, where they look into the adaption in climates to grow sustainable agricultural?
 - Region 6 is doing a bit of work in this area, in addition to what MDA (as a whole) may consider. Emma hasn't heard too much about this, but this doesn't necessarily mean that no one is looking into.
- Almond Board Australia recent media release, MDA in support. The suggestion was raised as part of the development approval for almond development Local Government could play the role in ensuring permanent water had to be included. Discussion: Perhaps water availability isn't the problem but water delivery is.
